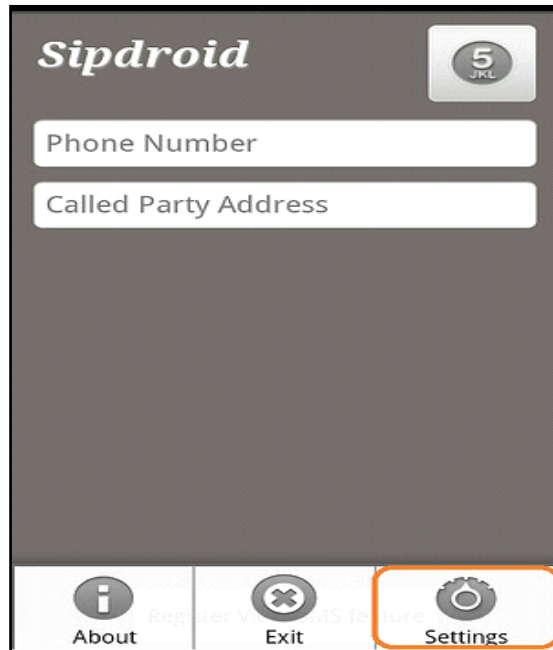
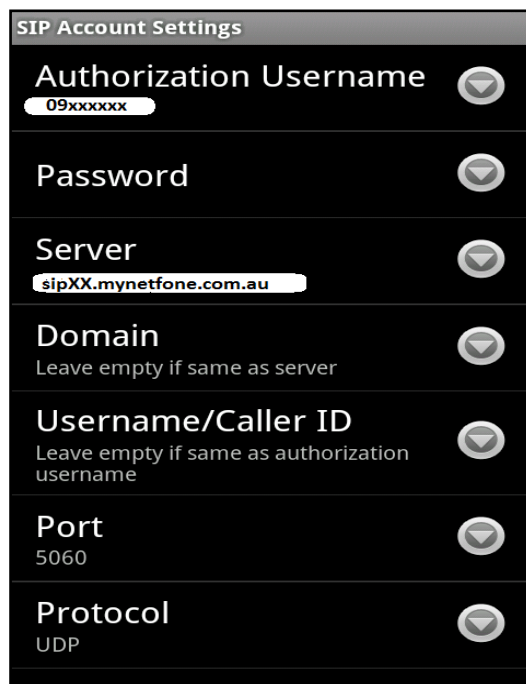


Setup Guide for Sipdroid

1. Download Sipdroid from Android Market
2. Open the Sipdroid app



3. Open Options and click on **Settings**. Once you select Settings, click on **Line 1** and you will see the following screen

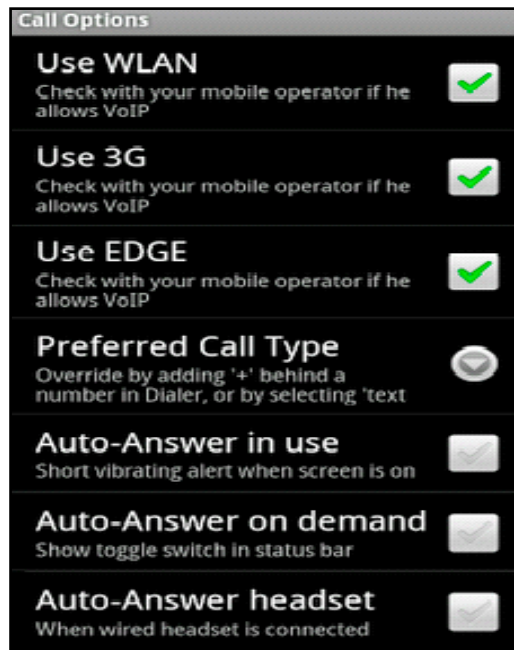


4. Enter the relevant information in the following fields:

Authorization username: Your MyNetFone SIP number (09xxxxxx)
Password: Your MyNetFone SIP password
Server: sip00.mynetfone.com.au or sip10.mynetfone.com.au

5. After entering this information, scroll down on the screen to another section and tick the preferred fields.

Note : Sipdroid will only use WIFI by default, if you intend to use your 3G connection for Sipdroid as well, then select 3G.



6. Check the top left corner of your screen and look for a **“green dot”**. This indicates that your Sipdroid is registered with the VoIP server and is ready to use.

If you see a **“red/orange dot”**, this means that Sipdroid is not registered. Please check the details you entered and re-enter.



7. You can exit Sipdroid by pressing the **Exit button**.

8. **To make calls**, simply go to your dialer or click “5” which will open up your dialler.

Note: Any calls you will make using Sipdroid will look like the screen image below. If you do not see the following screen, it means the calls are going through your mobile phone network.
