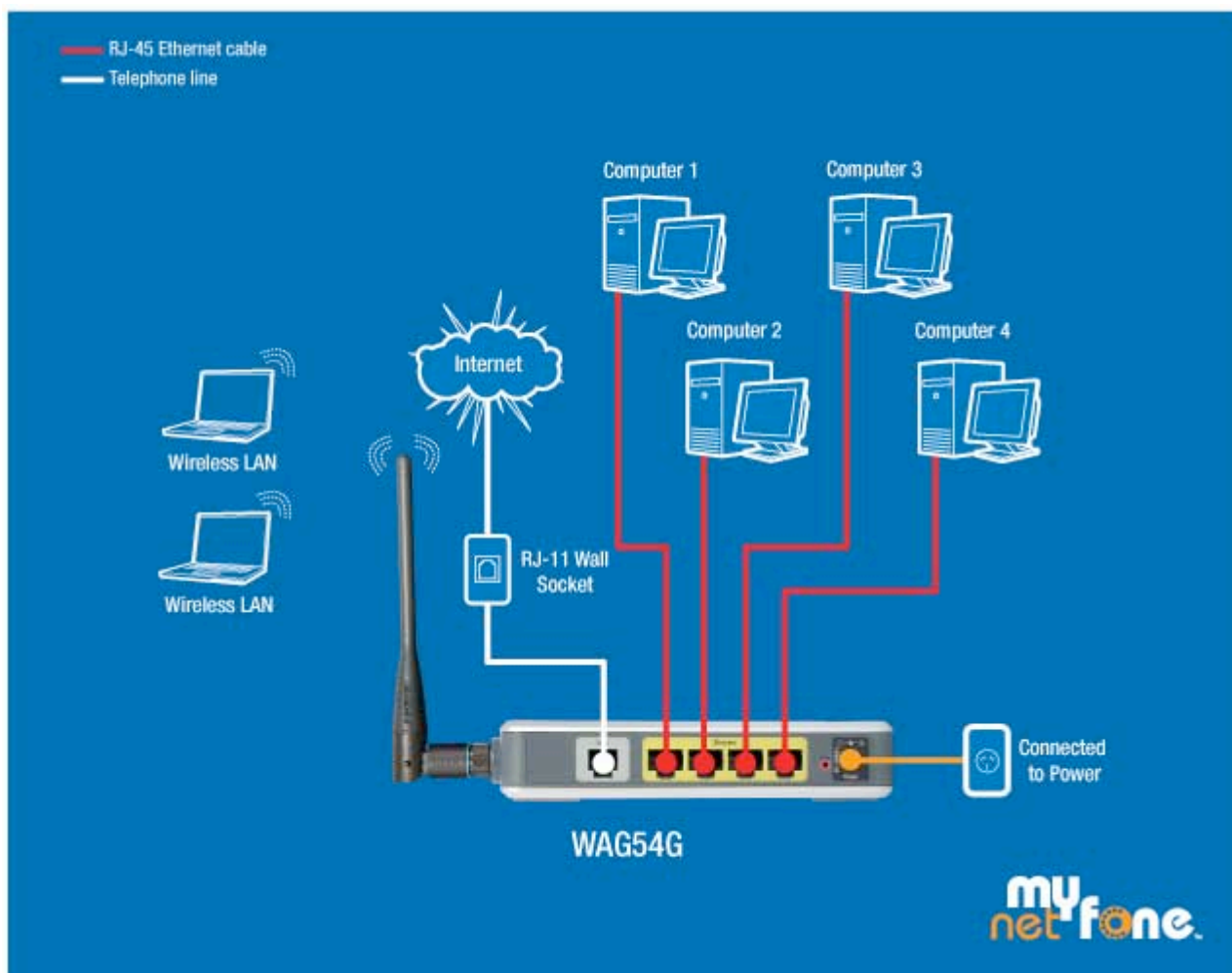


## Linksys by Cisco WAG54G Connection guide

Please refer to the diagram below to connect your Linksys by Cisco WAG54G.

**Please note:** Your Linksys by Cisco WAG54G is pre-configured on the MyNetFone Service. When your service is all setup & ready, you will receive a Service Confirmation email from MyNetFone - Please do not connect the device until you have received this email.



### NOTE:

- Line filter/splitter will no longer be necessary since normal Public Switched Telephone System (PSTN) will no longer be active on Naked ADSL2+ service. However you can still make phone calls using MyNetFone Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) services.
- Wireless networking is disabled by default for security purposes; you will need to enable it yourself before using it.

### Connecting the Modem Router

- Connect the Line port of the modem directly into your telephone wall socket with the provided line cord.
- Connect the Ethernet port of each computer to Ethernet / LAN port of the router.
- Connect the provided Power Adapter to the Power jack of the router and plug the adapter into the mains power outlet.
- Switch on the router. In normal operation, the following LED light should be on: Power, DSL, Ethernet / LAN. PPP light will turn if the connection is established successfully.
